On behalf of the Organizing Committee of the Third edition of the CIEHC, Congo's International Hydrocarbons Conference and Exhibition, I would like to extend our thanks to all participants that joined us at the event. Over 750 participants were present throughout the three days of CIEHC, making it the largest oil and gas event in Central Africa.

In 2016 The Republic of Congo's oil production hit 317'000 bbl/day, going from fourth, in 2015, to third position of Sub-Saharan Africa's largest producers. This production is set to increase, as production ramps up in existing fields and the interest in the 2016 licensing round, whose results will be announced later this year, and the proposed licensing round for 2017/2018.

There were a total of 56 speakers that intervened in the program, representing both the public and private sector, showcasing the developments and future of the sector, addressing some of the issues that are affecting the industry today, and presenting infrastructure development opportunities.
