**Abstract length:** minimum 200 - maximum 400 words in good English, no Pictures/graphs, no tradenames.

**Abstract content:** major new contributions in terms of knowledge or experience in the oil & gas business, possible applications of the information provided, results and major conclusions, any technical, economic and innovation contributions.
